### PLASTIC PACKAGING



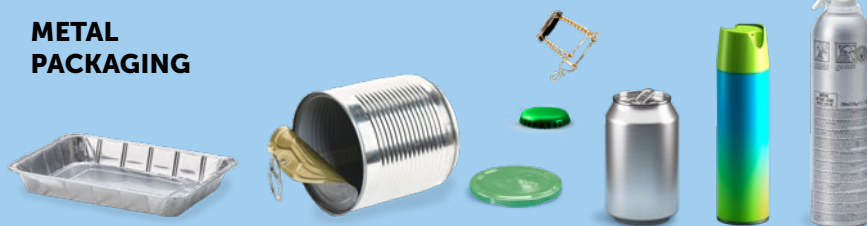
Common packaging in the horeca.



Films and bags smaller than 1m<sup>2</sup>  
and buckets smaller than 8 litres.

### Rules for proper recycling



Empty packaging  
completely.



Do not put items  
inside one another.



Don't tie small bags  
filled with PMD.

## What is not allowed in the PMD



Gas cylinders, batteries  
and electr(on)ical  
appliances.



Packaging  
> 8 litres.

Packaging featuring one  
of these **pictograms**  
and/or packaging  
with **child-resistant**  
fastenings.



ACUTE  
TOXICITY  
(GHS06)



CHRONIC  
TOXICITY  
(GHS08)



Industrial films,  
pallet covers  
and bags larger  
than 1 m<sup>2</sup>.



Packaging made of **a combination of**  
**materials** (e.g. plastic film layer + aluminium  
film layer) which cannot be separated, like  
some bag-in-box packagings and coffee  
packagings.
